Founded in 1964, Thomas Sumter Academy is an independent, Christian, co-educational college preparatory school for students in pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade. Campus is located in a rural Sumter community near Shaw Air Force Base.

Students are from a variety of backgrounds that represent different and unique ethnic and cultural groups. The student body of 2025 consisted of 492 total students; 175 in high school; and 42 in the senior class. Military families comprise approximately 39% of our student body.

CLASS RANKING POLICY

Thomas Sumter Academy follows the South Carolina Uniform Grading Policy (SCUGP). The SCUGP is utilized for each course that earns a Carnegie unit. The SCUGP includes weighted grades for honor, advanced placement, and dual enrollment courses. The SCUGP is used to calculate the grade point average (GPA) for each course that receives a Carnegie unit credit. Class rank is determined using the student's cumulative GPA; students are arranged from highest grade point average report with at least two decimal places that may not be rounded up. The class rank is calculated at the end of each year and includes all students that attend Thomas Sumter Academy during the school year.

Thomas Sumter Academy's Letter Grade Scale for grades six through twelve is as follows: A = 90-100 B = 80-89 C = 70-79 D = 60-69 F = 0-59
